

Activity 6: Using grid references

Look at the map of Australia below. The letters across the top and the numbers down the sides of the map are the grid references. By following the column down from the letter, and the row across from the number, you can find where they intersect (cross). This is the grid reference point. For example, Canberra is located where letter I and number 8 intersect. This would be referred to as I 8.
